Name of Yacht of which I am owner. The yacht is registered as a British ship and I have extracted the following particulars from the Certificate of Registry:-

I undertake:-

1. To return the warrant for cancellation:
 - a) If the Ministry of Defence recall it at any time
 - b) When I cease to be a member of the Club
 - c) When the Yacht ceases to belong solely to me
2. Not to use the yacht for any commercial purpose whatsoever.
3. To only permit the Club Ensign to be flown when I am personally in command of the yacht, and that the warrant is carried on board the yacht.

I understand that the warrant will authorise me to use the Ensign only on the Yacht named therein, and on any boat belonging to her which can conveniently be hoisted on board, and that the Ensign may be flown only whilst the Warrant is carried on board the yacht, and I am effectively in charge of the yacht.
